

**Map Information**

From Tuesday afternoon wildfires are raging the island of Evia and the north sector of Attica region in Greece, burning down large forests, urban interfaces and rural areas. The moderate wind, high temperatures and high flammability of forest, make the work of firefighters very difficult. Several firefighters with numerous vehicles are currently operating in the affected areas.

The present map shows the fire delineation in the area of Evia (Greece). The thematic layer has been derived from post-event satellite image by means of visual interpretation. The scale of analysis is 1:25000. The estimated geometric accuracy (RMSE) is 6.25 m or better, from native positional accuracy of the background satellite image. The minimum mapping unit (MMU) is 625 sqm.
